

## **Renovation Update**

I would like to take this opportunity to update you on the status of the Weston Lakes Capital Improvement Plan (CIP). Several years ago, WLCC embarked on approximately \$8,000,000 to our CIP program. Phase 1 was completed with the development of a new Pro Shop, Fitness Center, 19th hole and Weston Room. We also upgraded the irrigation system for the golf course along with construction of the 7/16 Concession station on the golf course. Additionally, we began a repair and replacement plan for the original golf paths.

Currently we are well into Phase 2 of our program. The development of the new Weston Lakes CC Recreational complex is underway; and is schedule to be completed in the Spring of 2023. The complex will include four tennis courts, an 8-lane competition pool, and a splash pad for the kids, a pavilion, complete with restrooms, concession area and a new multi-purpose sports field.

Also included in the Phase 2 program are improvements planned for the golf course. The bulk of these golf course improvements will begin in the Fall of 2022. Improvements will include:

- 1. Renovation of green side bunkers
- 2. Renovation and regrassing of all greens
- 3. Expansion and resodding of the putting green
- 4. Expansion and resodding of several tee boxes
- 5. Replace and upgrade of all course signage and course markers

Phase 3 plans over the next 3 to 5 years will include:

- 1. Expansion of club parking lot.
- 2. Upgrade of existing family pool and restrooms and convert to adult pool.
- 3. Development of outdoor entertainment venue in adult pool area.
- 4. Continued renovation and replacement of golf course cart paths.

We appreciate your patience while we are under construction on these projects. Our commitment is to continue to strive to upgrade our club and the experience for all our members.

#### Weston Lakes is for the Birds Part 3!

This community loves our birds and KWLB, along with your sponsorship, donations, and work is creating a Bird Sanctuary in Weston Lakes to provide habitat to attract more birds and provide opportunities for the community to enjoy them.





So what do birds need? They need food, water, and shelter. In the last two editions,

we talked about food and water, so this month let's talk about shelter. Shelter is important for the safety and security of our winged friends. Branches, leaves, and long grass can provide a haven for birds by



hiding them from view of predators. A safe shelter is especially important for nesting birds that need to protect their nest and their hatchlings. Providing

native evergreen and deciduous trees and shrubs will help a variety of species meet their specific needs. Adding nest boxes provides supplemental shelter for species such as our Eastern Bluebirds.



Our June event with Stroll Weston Lakes' Doughnuts and Discovery was an informative and inspiring morning. The program was provided by Naomi's Grace, a non-profit dedicated to reducing pediatric drowning by increasing water-safety awareness.



Naomi's Grace was founded by Jessica Mollon, a mother from Katy, after her twoand-a-half year old daughter, Naomi Grace, accidentally drowned in a family member's backyard hot tub on Memorial Day 2019. Adults and kids were moved by Jessica's presentation, learned

a lot of statistics about drowning deaths, and given important safety tips for keeping kids safe around water. After the interactive presentation, the kids let their energy loose with some highly competitive water

balloon fights. Both teams came out winners with prizes for all!

Afterwards the kids helped to keep Weston Lakes beautiful by picking up all the little pieces of balloons from the park. KWLB thanks the many awesome volunteers that helped with the event, including our youth









volunteers, Lilly Smith, Colton McAbee, Liam Clay, Chase Kuhn, Luke Polasek, and Luke Beierle.




